Federal Minimum Wage



Effective July 24, 2009, employers subject to the federal minimum wage law must now post in a conspicuous location the current rate.

Note: Since many states have their own minimum wage laws, an employee may be subject to the higher minimum wage rate.

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Minimum Wage

The federal minimum wage is \$7.25 per hour. Employers must now post in a conspicuous location the current rate. If so, the employee is entitled to the higher minimum wage rate.
